Our Mission

Animal Aid of Portland enhances the welfare of companion animals through individualized care and lifelong commitment, rescue and adoption, resources and education, and community partnerships.

Our Vision

Our vision is to be a recognized leader within a united local animal welfare community by working as a team of invested staff and volunteers to empower compassionate stewardship for thriving companion animals.

These objectives were developed from a 2022 supporter survey, staff and board input, and rich collaborative conversation. We are grateful to all the volunteers, partners, and supporters who provided feedback during this process.

Our Strategic Objectives

Objective 1: Create an Environment Where Each Animal and Each Human Has a Chance to Thrive

- A. Strengthen and expand dog foster program including evaluation of intake process.
- B. Enhance volunteer culture through active cultivation, acknowledgement, educational opportunities, and establishment of greater volunteer input and feedback.
- C. Support staff education and professional development goals.
- D. Evaluate staff responsibilities, capacity, and needs for future development and growth.

Objective 2: Provide Community Education and Raise Awareness of Our Programs

- A. Expand use of social media, email, and other communication tools to highlight educational materials and programs.
- B. Develop updated regular and limited edition branded merchandise for promotion and fundraising.
- C. Engage retirement communities and seniors with programs, presentations, and activities at the shelter and in the community.
- D. Engage youth through humane education presentations and activities via school and youth programs.
- E. Develop community educational programs on animal guardianship.



Objective 3: Strengthen and Create Partnerships to Maximize Resources

- A. Cultivate strategic partnerships to enhance and grow It Takes a Pack including storage, new volunteers, and pet stores partners.
- B. Enhance and grow the Animal Aid Cares Fund through:
 - a. Evaluation of the program policy to best serve people and pets in our communities.
 - b. Cultivate veterinary partnerships and engagement in underserved communities.
- C. Develop and enhance synergistic relationships with animal-centric and adjacent organizations.
- D. Actively seek to understand our wider market and community to develop and enhance the diversity of partnerships.
- E. Develop resources to better promote opportunities related to bequests, the Endowment Fund, and Gift of Life.
